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reviewed together in both hospital trusts. Guidance to be added to the formulary when available.

## 4. Prescribing in Alzheimer's disease

This combined guidance was agreed for the formulary. DPT advised that they would be using the drug with the lowest acquisition costs as first-line. There was discussion about the frequency of reviews of the patients with the specialist services.

Action: to ascertain from both CCGs what service is being commissioned in regard to reviewing patients taking drugs for dementia

### 5. **Chapter 17 Wound management**

TM outlined the PCH First dressings Initiative (agenda item 6). This initiative aims to save waste by providing District Nurses with a stock of dressings to be used on the first visit to the patient. Torbay has a similar pilot running.

Paper 5a summary of wound care products. There was discussion and questions asked about the reasons for the differences between South Devon and Plymouth. No response had been made from South Devon to initial comments made on the product choices. It was agreed to move the following items into the core list:

- Atrauman (green)
- Adaptic (red)
- C-view (red)
- Hydrofilm, Hydrofilm plus (green),
- Tegaderm (blue)
- Sorbsan ribbon (green)
- Biatain products (blue)

- Cavi-care (red)
- Activeheal hydrogel (green)
- Zetuvit, Zetuvit plus (green)
- Advazorb products (amber)
- Activeheal foam (green)
- Allevyn gentle (amber)

All shaped dressings have been removed except for Mepilex heel, used in PHNT podiatry. Intrasite conformable has not been added. The committee agreed that there does need to be an agreement with the TV services for a wider core list and very few trust specific products. AG offered to attend the next meeting to help with the discussions.

Action: TM to organise a meeting of TV to gain agreement of a wider core list, inviting AG to attend

It was agreed to publish the wound management chapter as agreed and further updates can be made as available.

#### 7. Chapter 9 Nutrition

Enteral nutrition and sip feeds:

DH had expressed concerns that the merged chapter would list a wide choice of products.
 Currently the SDJF have a small GP list and the remainder covered by a statement indicating specialist initiation. This was discussed and it was agreed to have a list of green and blue GP choices and a statement, rather than a list, for products initiated by the dieticians. The committee requested that clear communication needs to be sent to the GPs when these products are recommended and that a clear date for ceasing treatment is advised.

Action: to email DH the re-formatted malnutrition tool which will be available on a website for the formulary to link to.



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• Gluten free products:

The advice in the formulary is from the Coeliac society, particularly in regard to the prescribing of 'luxury' items

• NHS England:

The treatments funded by NHS England should be clearly identified, to indicate that new patients should be receiving their treatment from secondary care. Cinacalet, darbepoetin and epoetin will be red, secondary care drugs

• It was agreed not to list in the formulary the intravenous fluids that are used only in secondary care, and also the products currently listed in the intravenous nutrition section

The merged chapter was agreed to be added to the website

8. Chapter 10 (the remainder)

This section was agreed to be added to the website. It was noted that Metoject® is currently secondary care only in South Devon.

9. Recent drug decisions including NICE
